WHO IS IT FOR?

Beginner, amateur, enthusiast, semi-pro and pro photographers. Any camera gear welcome (DSLR, mirrorless, compact, smartphone). Also perfect for any nature lover who wants to experience an authentic African safari, even if photography is not their primary focus.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION – FAQs

Q: Which airport should I fly to?

A: International flights must arrive at Lusaka International Airport (LUN), from where you will take a domestic flight with Proflight Zambia (<https://proflight-zambia.com/>) to Mfuwe Airport (MFU), the gateway to South Luangwa National Park.

Q: Do I need a visa?

A: Many nationalities (EU, USA, Canada, Australia, etc.) are exempt. Others can get a visa on arrival (approx. 25 USD single entry). Always check with your local Zambian embassy.

Q: Are vaccinations required?

A: Yellow fever vaccination is not required for Zambia unless arriving from a yellow fever endemic country. We strongly recommend being up-to-date on routine vaccines and considering malaria prophylaxis. Always consult a travel doctor before departure.

Q: What should I pack?

A: Lightweight, breathable clothing in neutral colors, insect repellent, a good sunhat, sunscreen, camera gear, and personal medications.

Q: Is there electricity at the camp?

A: Yes, for charging camera batteries and essential electronics. We advise bringing spare batteries and memory cards.

Q: Is tipping expected?

A: Tipping is customary. Suggested guideline: USD 5–10 per guest per night for camp staff; USD 10 per day for guides.

Q: Is the area malaria-free?

A: No. South Luangwa is a malaria area. Preventive medication and protection against mosquito bites are strongly recommended.

Terms and Conditions:

Confirmed reservation: A reservation is only confirmed upon written confirmation and payment of a 30% deposit of the total amount. (Non-refundable).

Final payments: The final payment must be made at least 3 months before departure. If the company does not receive the final payment by the due date, we reserve the right to cancel all arrangements without notice. Reservations made within 3 months days prior to departure will only be processed with full payment. (Non-refundable).

Insurance: It is mandatory for clients to purchase comprehensive travel insurance, including cancellation insurance, taking into account any unforeseen events that may arise.

It is the responsibility of guests to obtain insurance that covers expenses from the moment of deposit payment until the conclusion of the reserved services. Comprehensive travel and cancellation insurance is required for all our safaris, and guests are expected to cover any costs related to cancellation fees, medical care (including medical repatriation if necessary), loss or damage to personal belongings, and any loss of cash they bring with them. Most cancellations will occur for reasons covered within the terms of a guest's travel insurance policy, and their travel insurers should reimburse

applicable cancellation fees, subject to the terms of their policy. However, if the coverage is insufficient, guests are expected to cover any shortfall themselves.

Trip cancellation: In the event that the minimum seats for the trip are not filled (6), the trip will be canceled and the total amount paid will be refunded.
